We are learning about the different seasons and how to represent each season through art. We are learning about colour, pattern, texture, line, shape and space.

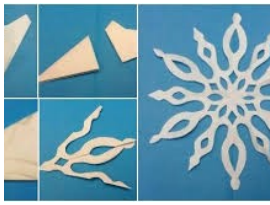

There are four seasons in the year. Each season can be represented through different colours.

Colours can be warm, soft, cool, dark, bright and light.

Vocabulary	Definition
pattern	An arrangement of lines or shapes that form a design.
photography	The skill or process of producing photographs.
colour	The way that something looks in the light. Red, yellow and blue are colours.
symmetry	Having two halves that are exactly the same.
line	A long, thin mark.
texture	The way that something feels when you touch it.
shape	Something such as a square, circle or triangle. A shape is created when a line is enclosed.
space	An area that is empty.
media	Media is the material and tools used by an artist or designer to create a work of art.

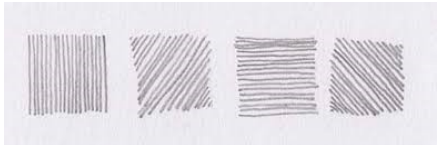

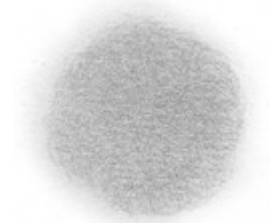

What have we already learnt?

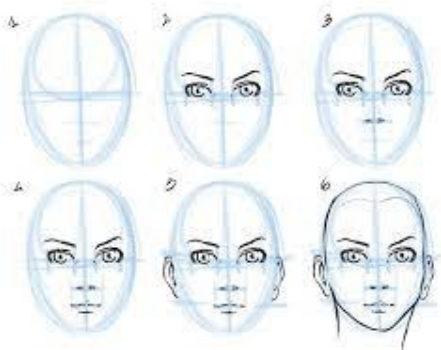
In the EYFS children have used and explored a variety of materials and have experimented to create different textures.

Vocabulary	Definition
portrait	A painting, drawing or photograph of a particular person.
Self-portrait	An artist draws or paints themselves.
artist	Someone who draws, paints or creates works or art.
hatching	A technique used to create shading effects by drawing closely spaced lines.
cross hatching	A shading technique created by drawing lines in one direction and then lines in another direction over the top.
shading	A technique that can let you add light and shadow to your drawings.
smudging	A technique that makes something smeared by rubbing it.
line drawing	A drawing done using lines without shading.
media	Media is the material and tools used by an artist or designer to create a work of art.

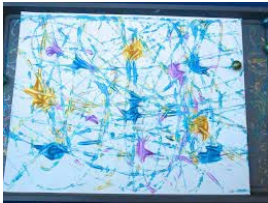
Colour Chaos

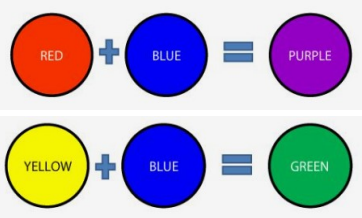

Red, blue and yellow are the three primary colours.

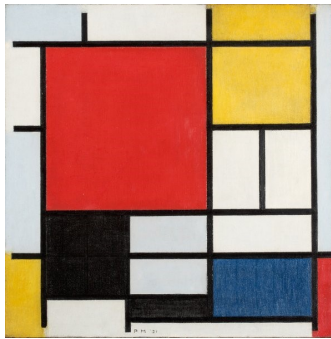
Vocabulary	Definition
printing	Using any object, applying paint or ink to it and using it to make a print directly onto another surface.
marble painting	Using marbles to create colourful lines on paper.
artist	Someone who draws, paints or creates works or art.
collage	A picture that you make by sticking pieces of paper on a surface.
watercolours	A coloured paint that is mixed with water and used for painting pictures.
primary colour	A colour from which all other colours can be obtained by mixing.
secondary	The colour you get from mixing two primary colours.
media	Media is the material and tools used by an artist or designer to create a work of art.

Jackson Pollock is an American painter who is best known for his 'drip technique' of splashing liquid onto a canvas.



Piet Mondrian is a Dutch artist best known for his use of bold colours in abstract art.
