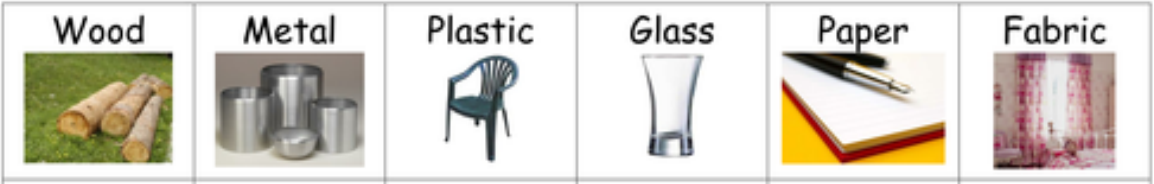


Wonderful Weather

We are learning about what the weather is like in our country and where we live.



In Science we are learning about everyday materials and their properties.



Vocabulary	Definition
Season	One of the four parts of the year that each have their own typical weather.
Spring	The season between winter and summer.
Summer	The season between spring and autumn. In summer the weather is usually warm or hot.
Autumn	The season between summer and winter when the weather becomes cooler and the leaves fall off the trees.
Winter	The season between autumn and spring. In the winter the weather is usually cold.
Temperature	How hot or cold something is.
Weather	The temperature or conditions outside. For example if it is wet, hot or windy.
Symbol	A number, a letter or a shape that represents a particular thing.
